Diagnosis: Haemophagocytic Lymphohistiocytosis (HLH)

This 6 year old boy was admitted to Sime Darby Medical Centre with severe pneumonia on 1/2/2012. He was admitted to the Intensive Care Unit for ventilatory support. In addition to his severe pneumonia, further investigations confirmed the disease Haemophagocytic Lymphohistiocytosis (HLH). This is a life-threatening disease and the patient needs to be treated with chemotherapy and perhaps may also need a stem cell transplantation in the near future, depending on his response to chemotherapy.

At the present moment, the patient remains ill and requires a lot of medical support. In the process of sorting out therapy for his HLH, he will also need HLA tissue-typing to search for potential stem cell donors and also testing for genetic mutations related to HLH. These tests need to be sent overseas.
